Seeking PhD-level Scientists and Engineers for a Year of Service in New Jersey State Government

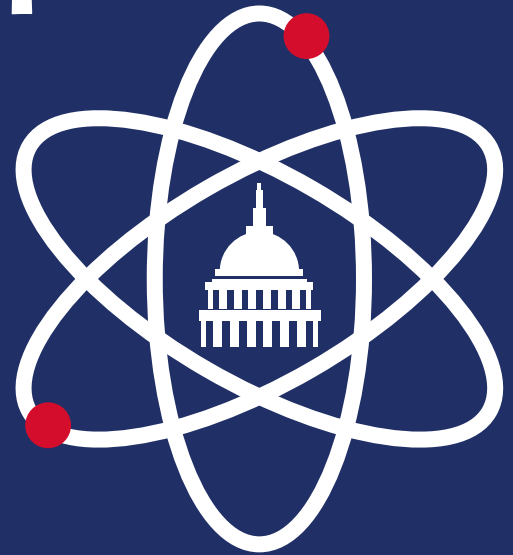
REQUIREMENTS

PhD-level degree in science, engineering, or technology

- One-year placement as a full-time aide in a NJ State Government legislative or executive branch office (July 2020-July 2021)
- Intensive orientation training in New Jersey politics and government (July 2020)
- Professional development trainings and events focused on skills and knowledge that can help scientists be effective in a government setting
- One-year stipend

This fellowship program is a unique opportunity for scientists to apply their expertise and knowledge to help solve public problems. Science Fellows will participate in the political process and support New Jersey state government officials in making evidence-based decisions in some of the many public policy areas involving science, engineering, and technology – while deepening their understanding of state government and how to build careers in public service.
